

Ministry Personnel and Congregations:

Annual Public Performance License for the showing of feature films (video and DVD)

Many of you already use feature films for study groups and congregational events. These films can be wonderful resources for nurturing Christian discipleship in our churches. However, unless you have negotiated your own public performance license, you are infringing upon the Canadian Copyright Act by showing these videos and DVDs.

To obtain a license that covers virtually all of the films you might want to show over the next year, Toronto Conference has arranged with Criterion Pictures and Audio Cine Films to administer an annual license to congregations. **The fee for this license is based on your Sunday attendance figures as reported in the 2007 Yearbook statistics (line 20). The yearly fee is \$1:14 per attendee (50 attendees = \$57 for the year).** Once your application has been received, a reporting package will be sent to you from the licensing companies. You can report video/DVD showings monthly to them on this form or online.

To apply for this license, please fill out the information on the application form attached and send this information along with your cheque (made out to "Toronto Conference") to Portia Harrison at Toronto Conference office. If you have questions contact:

This license covers the period Apr 1, 2009 – Mar. 31, 2010. Applications and cheques will be received immediately or at any time during the year. However, the license will apply only to this period.
