The 86th annual meeting of Toronto Conference took place on the weekend of May 28-30, 2010 at St. Paul's United Church, Orillia.

FRIDAY, MAY 28, 2010

EVENING SESSION

Gathering music

Gathering music was led by Stuart Sladden.

Welcome, theme, honouring the land and constituting the Court

President Carol Gierak welcomed people to the 86th annual meeting of the Conference and acknowledged the Rama First Nation on whose land the meeting was being held. Karen Hilfman-Millson lit the Christ candle. The president spoke about the theme of this annual meeting, "From this Day on, I will Bless you" from Haggai 2:19b. She read the passage Haggai 2: 14-19. The president constituted the meeting in the name of Jesus Christ to conduct business properly brought before it.

Proposal to Toronto Conference #1 - Budget

Executive Secretary David Allen presented the 2011 budget. He responded to questions from the floor.

MOTION by David Allen/Marg Walker that this 86th annual meeting of Toronto Conference approve the 2011 budget and receive for information the projected budgets for 2012 and 2013.

Executive secretary accountability report

Executive Secretary David Allen presented his accountability report. No questions had been submitted.

Proposal to Toronto Conference #2 – poverty reduction strategy

Brian McIntosh made a brief presentation on the Proposal and answered questions for clarification.

MOTION by David Allen/Marg Walker that Toronto Conference communicate with the Government of Ontario to a) commend steps taken to date to reduce poverty in Ontario among all age groups, and b) request the adoption of further measures including but not limited to the following:

1. Adequate Income

- guarantee that the Social Assistance Review results in enhancements and does not reduce services or benefits for Workfare and Ontario Disability Support Program recipients
- continue to raise the minimum wage, currently \$10.25 an hour
- encourage employers to offer benefits to all workers, both full-time and part-time
- provide vocational assessments in conjunction with increased training and retraining opportunities
- to encourage educational upgrading, remove age limit for LEAP program
- provide legislation to protect the pensions of laid –off workers
- enhance English Second Language Programs to ensure that students can achieve employers' standards
- provide increased sheltered employment opportunities for physically or mentally disabled persons who wish to work
- change the age of leaving parental supervision from 16 to 18 years of age
- call on Ottawa to expand Employment Insurance coverage
- act to protect pension plans for seniors and lobby for the reduction of cutbacks to pensions

2. Affordable Housing

- require municipalities to increase the number of available rent-to-income units
- encourage affordable options to townhouses or apartments such as stacked units

- provide tax or other incentives to builders who incorporate scattered rent-to-income units in market value housing projects
- require municipalities to maintain emergency shelters in good repair and encourage use of options which enhance privacy such as trailers, apartment hotels and so on
- ensure adequate supported housing units for youth, seniors and severely mentally ill and disabled persons

3. Personal Support

- ensure the provision of easily accessible services in low income communities including Legal Aid, credit counselling, marriage counselling, family planning, addictions counselling, and mental health support programs
- require school boards to offer Life Skills courses as part of both their regular and Continuing Education programs
- provide childcare in conjunction with English Second Language courses
- ensure Official Guardians are available to the mentally ill or disabled who lack family support
- ensure that adequate subsidized daycare spaces are provided in conjunction with the implementation of full-day kindergarten.

Former president John Lee read the scripture.

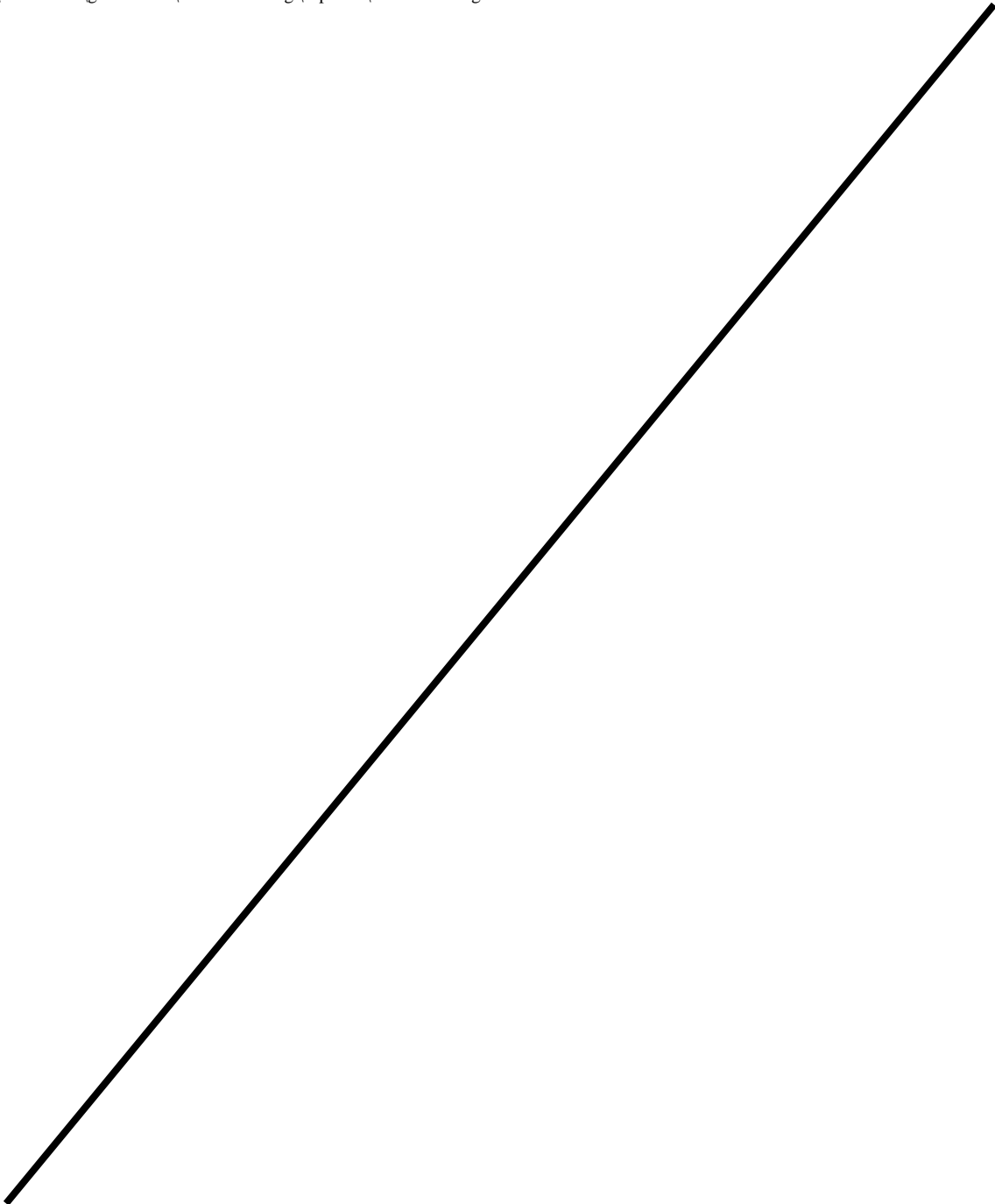

Frank Dalton (February 14, 2010)

Peacefully surrounded by his loving family on Sunday, February 14, 2010 at the Scarborough General Hospital in his 68th year. Cherished husband of Linda. James Homer Dean (May 22, 1913 - March 19, 2010)

Rev. Lt. Col. Homer Dean was truly Paterfamilias to us his children and our families, a large clan of Deans and Woodburns and a huge host of friends from nine to 90. He had a lifelong gift of touching people in ways they treasured: marrying and burying, counselling and comforting. Homer was a skilled carpenter, who rebuilt an 1865 log cabin on Georgian Bay. There he and his treasured wife Jean welcomed visitors every summer for six decades. He archived family histories and artifacts. He read and wrote widely and could converse on almost any topic.

After graduating from Victoria and Emmanuel Colleges, University of Toronto, he served 1940-1950 as United Church Minister in Nobel, Dundalk and Kirkton, Ontario; 1950-1969 with the RCAF in Camp Borden, Germany and Ottawa; and finally at United Church Headquarters, Toronto until 1978. In retirement, he was ever engaged with people and creative projects. Jean Woodburn Dean (1907-2001) was the love of his life. They are survived by three children James, Loral, Tom; seven grandchildren Jacqueline, Seumas, Sofya, Ginger, Yvonne, Cosmo and Jamie; and one great-grandchild Magnus Alexander Belza.

Duncan Kennedy Fleming (September 13, 2009)

Passed away peacefully on Sunday, September 13, 2009 in his 82nd year, surrounded by his family, at Victoria Village Manor in Barrie, Ontario. Recently predeceased by his wife, Eva. He came to Hamilton Conference in 1976 from Winnipeg Presbytery and was called to Erindale United in Halton Presbytery where he served until 1981. He variously served at Runnymede United in Toronto, First United in Waterloo and Fairlawn Heights in Toronto and retired in 2006.

One of the goals of the restructuring was to bring the resources of the Conference closer to the congregational level of the church. Some commentary on the budget based on the mission statement:

1. Strengthening... to be faithful followers of Jesus Christ

Most of this work happens at the Presbytery level of the church. Confirmation retreats, events for young people, training for Ministry & Personnel Committees, re-constituting a crisis response team to aid congregations in distress, workshops on building right relations, and presentations on social issues are a few examples of the initiatives that help to strengthen congregations to be faithful followers of Jesus Christ. Conference activities include the work of the settlement and pastoral relations committee which attempts to match congregations and ministers

to ensure effective ministry, consultations on mission support and stewardship, and processing financial grant applications. A personnel emergency fund provides short-term assistance to ministers needing counselling.

2. Making the best use of human and financial resources

All costs of the Presbytery offices are included in the budget. A common telephone system allows access to all staff using one telephone number, and staff have access to all computer files through a single computer network which is also tied in to the General Council computer system. All staff are supervised by the executive secretary. One of the outcomes of the restructuring is that the Conference office is primarily an administrative centre while Presbyteries look after program work. There is no overlap between the two Courts in administrative and program work. The Conference's finance and property administrator has oversight of all financial matters for the Conference and the four Presbyteries, paying all bills based on Presbytery-approved budgets; and she manages all of the offices, ensuring that the offices are well supplied, as well as looking after all necessary repairs.

3. Ensuring oversight and compliance

The Conference has numerous responsibilities which fall under the headings of oversight and compliance. Oversight includes responsibility for the religious life of the United Church. It has specific oversight of the four Presbyteries. It looks after interviews for those in the various ministry processes; it ordains, commissions, admits and recognizes ministers. It oversees policies such as mandatory racial justice training and the sexual abuse policy of the United Church. Conference oversees the marriage licence registration system as required by the province, supervises more than 30 Incorporated Ministries, is a liaison with the General Council, elects and interacts with General Council Commissioners, and plans an annual meeting with up to 500 people present from every part of the Conference.

4. providing resources to the Presbyteries

More than 70% of this budget is spent in the Presbyteries. The largest single item, of course, is staffing, but it also includes support for the governance and committee structures of the Presbyteries. Congregations benefit from the universal membership in AVEL, the audio-visual library which is part of the Grand River Spiritual and Education Resources bookstore at Five Oaks. In addition, the archival services of the United Church are available. There is no separate Presbytery assessment.

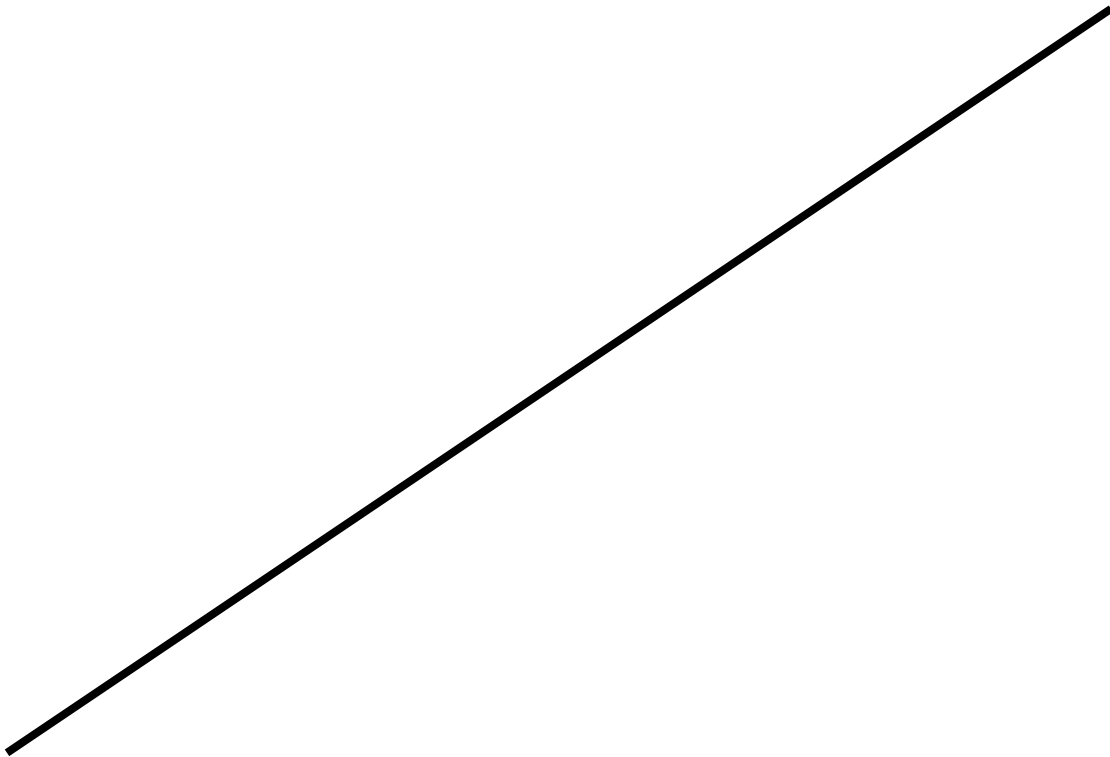
Budget assumptions: a) Some of the figures will require revision as new information is received from the General Council. Examples include i) staff salaries which are calculated to increase by 2.2 percent. ii) The General Council grant is flat-lined for

budget purposes. iii) The archival costs are flat-lined for 2011. c) All other budgeted items are calculated at a 2.5 percent increase.

Concluding comments: a) 2010 is the first full budget year where all Conference and Presbytery expenses have been combined. By the end of this calendar year, we will have a good sense of the costs of the new system. b) There is a slight budget decrease in 2011. c) Like most congregations, the largest single item in the budget is staff salaries. The projected increases in 2012 and 2013 are based primarily on the current staff moving through the salary steps within their categories.

Assessment method: The 2008 annual meeting adopted a new assessment method which took effect January 1, 2010. The Assessment Commission explained the formula in its report to the 2008 annual meeting:

The recommendation from the Assessment Commission for a new formula to be used to calculate the assessment from Toronto Conference to the Pastoral Charges is made up of two parts. Half of the annual budget requirement will use the membership number taken from column 16 of the statistical form. The Pastoral Charge membership will be taken as a percentage of the total membership of Toronto Conference as published in the prior year's Year Book. The other half of the annual budget will be based on column 40 of the Statistical Report – Operating Expenses. Again, the Pastoral Charge amount will be changed to a percentage of the total of column 40 for the whole of Toronto Conference as published in the prior year's Year Book. The 2010 Assessment will be based on the 2009 Year Book which publishes the 2008 statistics.

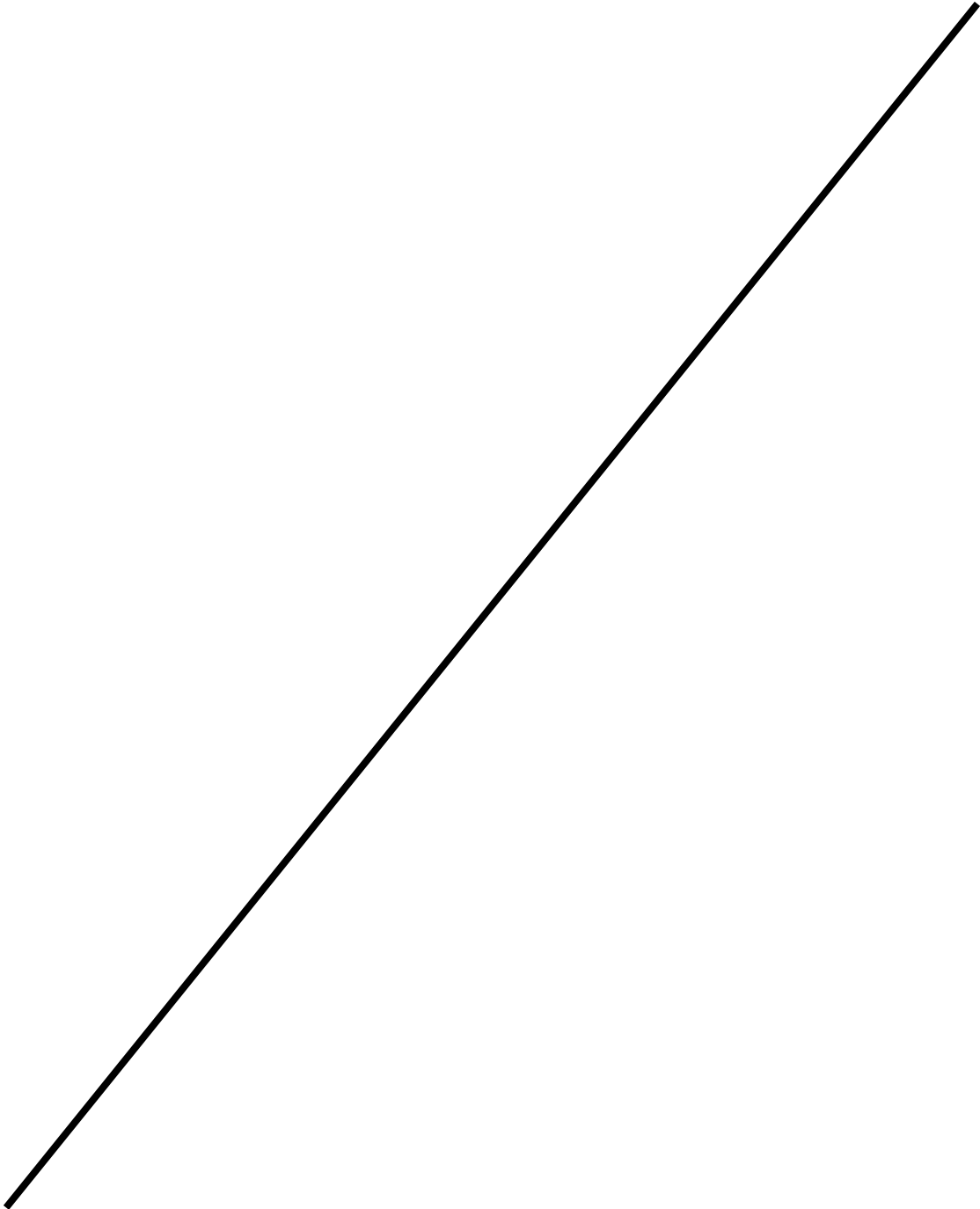

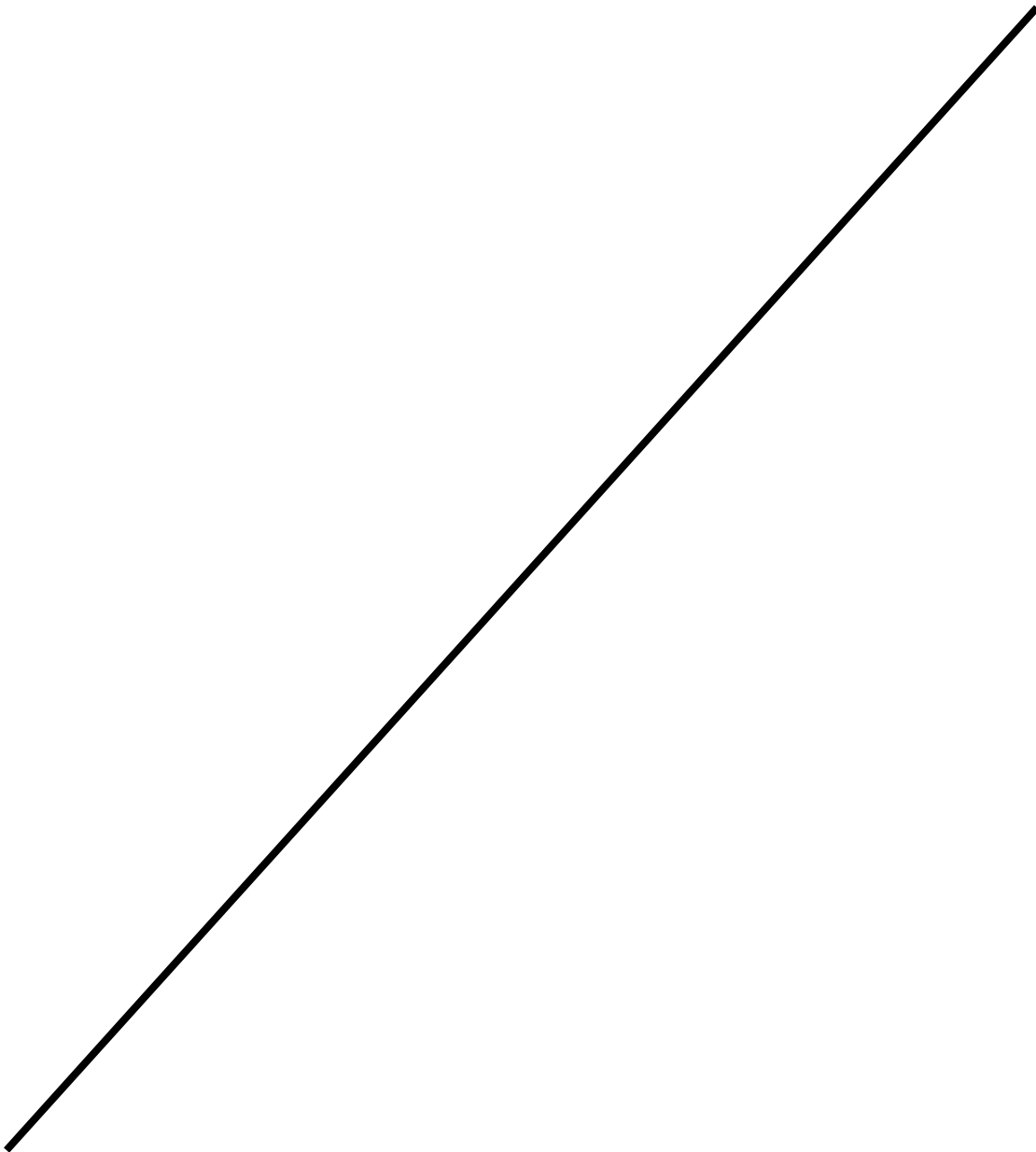

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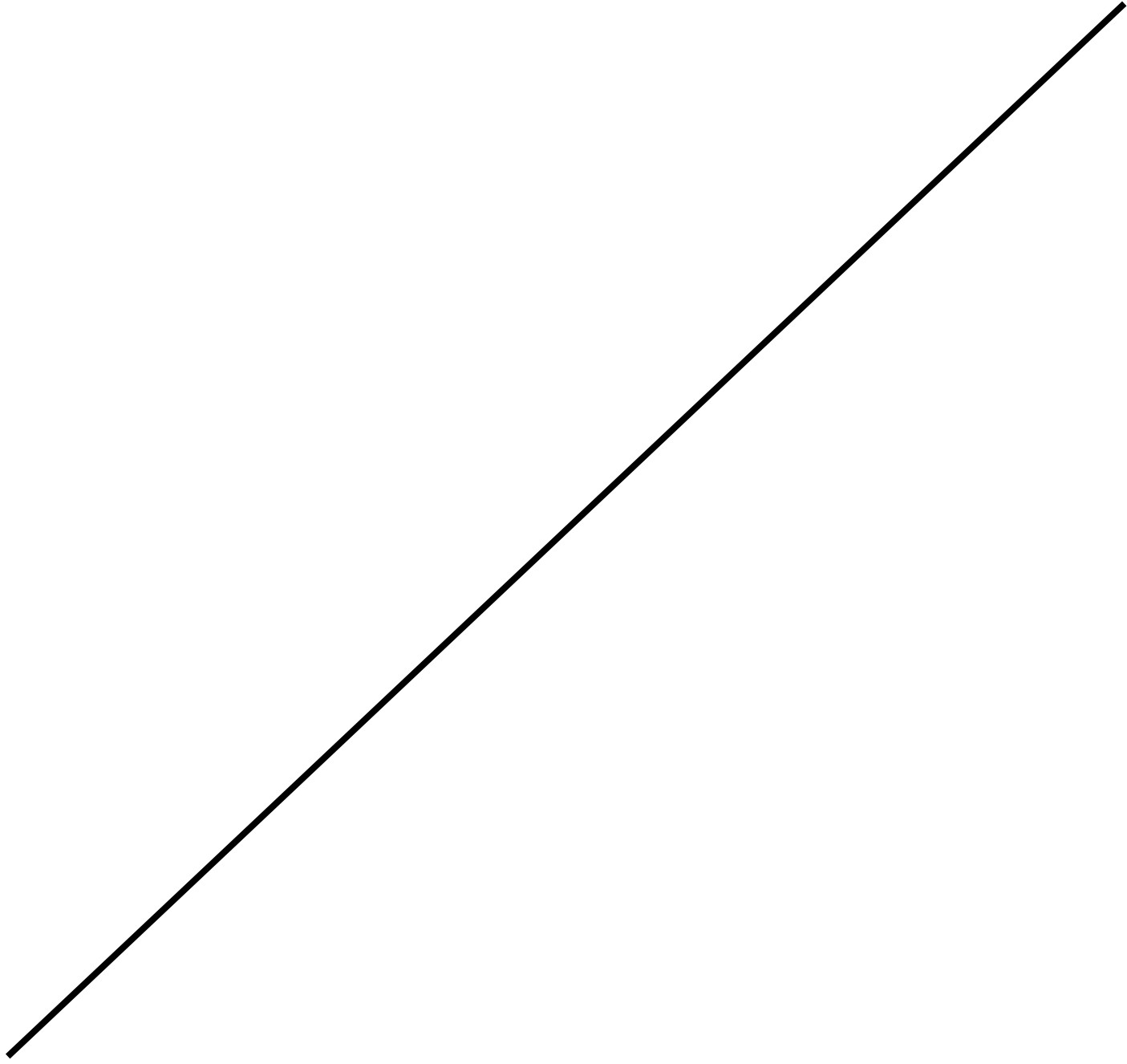
