Bloor Street has submitted a very compelling offer to the general Council Executive to house the General Office within our development project. We have provided a solution that meets their objective of having a “sacred space” while allowing them to reduce space requirements by sharing our sanctuary and service faculties. It provides them with their own building with their own entrance and signage in the heart of mid town Toronto. Moreover it does so at a significant savings in costs over their current cost.
